BOARD UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTS 2022 BUDGET

The Macomb County Board of Commissioners unanimously passed a balanced 2022 budget at its Full Board Meeting today. After many hours spent in multiple public meetings, the Board adopted a budget that very closely aligned with the recommended budget received from the County Executive.

Highlights of the 2022 budget include:

- Total budget exceeds \$1 billion
- \$284 million General Fund
- \$3.7 million surplus
- Planning for the future with a 26 percent fund balance of \$76 million
- Elimination of a tax to support Martha T. Berry, saving taxpayers \$1.3 million
- Supporting public safety by investing in the Prosecutor's Office
- Supporting investments in the Health Department and strengthening its ability to respond to the pandemic

"The Board of Commissioners takes great pride in the fact that the adopted budget best serves the citizens of Macomb County," said Board Chair Don Brown. "We strive to always put the needs of our community at the forefront and are committed to ensuring, to the taxpayers, responsible spending."

"We had a thorough process in place to review this budget," said Finance/Audit/Budget Committee Chair, Joe Sabatini. "We dissected each department's budget at public meetings to ensure our fiduciary duty to the taxpayers."
